
# SR.**G-FLEX**™

### FLEXIBLE EXPANDED POLYSTYRENE INSULATION

The flexible SR.G-Flex<sup>™</sup> insulating panels manufactured by Styro Rail<sup>™</sup> are composed of Type 2 or Type 3 expanded polystyrene laminated on each side by a polypropylene membrane.




# **RECOMMENDED USE**

Install the SR.G-Flex<sup>TM</sup> panels underneath the finished basement concrete slab and of residential and commercial garage concrete slab. Ideal when the backfill material is uneven – the panels stay interconnected to one another through the G-Lock<sup>TM</sup> ship lap system and the flexibility of the panel.

# PANEL DESCRIPTION/COMPOSITION

- A Type 2 or Type 3 Rigid expanded polystyrene insulating panel [EPS] manufactured by Styro Rail™
- B Polypropylene membrane on each side





# **GENERAL INSTALLATION**

- 1 Compact the backfill material.
- 2 Install and seal a vapor barrier.
- 3 Leave approximately a 305 mm [12"] strip at the bottom of the wall. Fold back the strip on the wall. Temporarily secure with an adhesive tape.
- 4 Apply an acoustic sealant<sup>†</sup> bead underneath the wall vapor barrier. Press firmly.
- 5 Begin the installation on an interior corner of the foundation. Using a knife with a retractable blade, cut ship laps towards wall.
- 6 Install the **SR.G-Flex**™ insulating panels. Butt ends between panels. Install panels continuously and uniformly.
- **7** Pour the concrete slab.
- 8 During the wall finishing; install and seal a vapor barrier.
- 9 Seal the vapor barrier of the slab with the vapor barrier of the wall.
- 10 Install a protective barrier such as gypsum boards.

# FINISHING SLAB [BASEMENT]

- 1 Install a type 2 expanded polystyrene strip of a minimum 50 mm [2"]\* in thickness on the vertical section of the vapor barrier.
- Calculate the height of the expanded polystyrene strip with the thickness of the concrete slab.
- 3 Install panels as described in this guide.

<sup>\*</sup> The expanded polystyrene strip can be reduced to 32 mm [1-1/4''] for the basement finishing slabs that does not contain ducts, heating pipe system or buried cables and that are located at least at 610 mm [24''] under the soil level.

<sup>†</sup> The acoustic sealant must be compatible with expanded polystyrene. Use *Tremco* acoustic sealant or equivalent.

# STORAGE AND COVERING

Store panels in a dry and ventilated location, protected from the outside elements, ultraviolet rays, open flames or other sources of ignition. Stack panels on pallets of minimum 100 mm [4"] above the ground. If provided packaging has been damaged during shipping, cover panels with a weather and ultraviolet tarp. Panels must be dry and in good condition before installation.
